The PMA Annual Awards given to component societies, specialty/affiliate societies and individual PMA members is a tradition aimed to give recognition to outstanding achievers and provide support to various PMA constituents through incentives which can further inspire them to elevate the standards of their work and accomplishments. The conduct of giving award and recognition should be meaningful and relevant not only to the recipients but to the whole PMA as well.

The Committee on Awards met on September 16, 2020 and the conduct of giving various awards were reviewed and revisited as deemed appropriate. The recommendations were presented to the PMA Board of Governors and such were approved, some with modifications.

To enable component/specialty/affiliate societies to participate in this annual, activity, this circular, which reflects the guidelines, is being disseminated for information and compliance.

Clarity, completeness and authenticity of report is likewise important. Thus, the following should be observed:

- For uniformity, the reports should be printed on a white letter size bond paper 8.5" (width) x 11" (height). Font Size: 11, Font Color - Black; Font Style: Arial Narrow
- All pictures should be in color, dated and properly labeled or captioned individually or as a group of pictures.
- The written report should be placed in a short clear book and also please submit the soft copy of the report in a USB/CD in WORD FORMAT.
- PMA Committee on Awards Form 01 Guide should be followed strictly in all quarterly reports.
- All reports should be signed by the Secretary, noted and endorsed by the President.

When vying for PMA award:

- Devote at most two additional pages for Executive Summary highlighting the important accomplishments of most significant activities with accompanying pictures integrated into the summary.
- There should be a Board resolution from the Component Society signifying their intention to vie any of the PMA Awards the society would like to join. (See Appendix A. Sample of Board of Resolution)
- When vying for special award, submit separate pages report in a folder securely fastened, accompanied by soft copy in word format. This will be submitted on April 8, 2021.
- With the approval of the Board of Governors we would like to inform all the Component Medical Societies that the award for the **Child Advocacy and Adopt-a-Barangay Project** will be put on hold for this fiscal year 2020-2021.

#### INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

- The component societies or specialty/affiliate societies are strongly encouraged to nominate outstanding physicians to appropriate category for the DR. JOSE P. RIZAL MEMORIAL AWARDS, such as: Academe, Clinical Practice, Community Leadership, Government Service and Research. Separate announcement will be sent in this regard. Deadline of submission of nominations will be announced later by the Committee in charge of Dr Jose P Rizal Memorial Award.
- All nominees should be recommended/endorsed by a Component Society, including those nominated by specialty society
- For the Most Outstanding Physician Award:
  - The Awards Committee would like to reiterate that for the MOP, incumbent Component/Specialty Division/Subspecialty/Affiliate Society President is NOT qualified for the award since he/she is part of the nominating committee of their respective Society.
  - All nominees to be qualified to this award must submit their curriculum vitae on or before January 8, 2021.
  - There should only be ONE nominee per Component/Specialty Division/Subspecialty/Affiliate Society for MOP
- A member of the Board of Governors cannot be nominated for individual award because the Board of Governor is the body that approve the award

#### II. PMA AWARD FOR EXEMPLARY CIVILIAN SERVICE TO PHILIPPINE MEDICINE

#### (initiated by component/specialty/subspecialty and affiliate society)

A. A Committee on Most Outstanding Physician Award of component/specialty/subspecialty/affiliate society should be organized composed of the following: President of the society as Chairman, plus 6 members who are or have been recipients of the same award, arranged according to seniority. In the absence of sufficient number of previous awardees, the Board and Officers and component societies will appoint the committee members.

# Members of the Committee and the Incumbent President are not eligible for this award during their incumbency.

All nominees to be qualified to this award must submit their curriculum vitae on or before January 8, 2021.

- B. Basic qualifications of nominees: Membership in component society for at least five (5) years continuous year except for component society, which has not been in existence that long. The candidate has no pending case against the PMA or any medical. Not incumbent President
- C. Each component/ specialty/ subspecialty/affiliate society can nominate only one candidate

D. Selection has to be according to the following criteria:

- Professional prestige and ethical conduct
- With the following Service to component society and PMA during his/her years of membership 40%
- Service to the community thru non-medical organization/s 20%
