SUBJECT : REQUEST FOR NOMINEES FOR THE PMA OUTSTANDING PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR AWARD

DATE : FEBRUARY 15, 2021

Warmest Greetings!

The PMA is once again requested by the Professional Regulation Commission to submit nominees for the Outstanding Professional of the Year Award. The award is given in recognition of the achievements and services of professionals who excelled in their respective fields of professional endeavor during their career. This is the highest award that could be conferred upon to a professional by the PRC.

In relation to this, may we request your societies to submit nominee/s for the selection of this particular award.

General Criteria:

1. Must be a citizen of the Republic of the Philippines;
2. Must be duly registered with the PRC with valid and current professional identification card;
3. Of good moral character and a member in good standing of the Accredited Professional Organization (APO) ; (if a member of APO);

4. Has not been found guilty in an administrative case, by a final and executor decision, rendered by a Professional Regulatory Board, the PRC, or the regular courts in case of an appeal;
5. Has not been convicted of a final judgment by a competent jurisdiction of any crime involving moral turpitude.
6. Has no pending case with any of the courts for criminal/civil offense or charges;
7. Not an officer or director of the national organization of APO for at least one (1) year prior to the nomination for the awards;
8. Not an incumbent member of the PRB nor an official or employee of the PRC; and
9. Not a past awardee of the PRC except for another profession which he/she is duly registered.

Detailed Criteria:

1. Sufficiently demonstrated professional competence of the highest degree and conducted himself/herself with integrity in the exercise of his/her profession	(30%) a. Integrity - 10% b. Technical Competence - 10% c. Academic background - 4% d. Training/CPD Compliant - 3% e. Experience - 3%
2. Meaningfully participated in professional activities through the accredited professional organization or any other professional organization	(30%) a. Leadership - 10% b. Projects / Accomplishments - 10% c. Conferences and seminars attended International- 6% Local - 4%
3. Significantly contributed to the advancement of the profession	(25%) a. Publication/Research Projects - 5% b. Positive impact to the profession 10% c. Awards and Recognition i. International - 6% ii. Local - 4%
4. Contributed significantly to the effective discharge of the profession's social responsibility through meaningful contribution / participation in socio-related activities	(15%) a. Involvement in Civic Organization 4% b. Community & Public Citations 4% c. Direct and personal involvement in Social Responsibility projects - 7%
TOTAL	100%

We would appreciate receiving the name/s of your nominees on or before **March 10, 2021** . Each nominee shall submit eight (8) copies of the following documents:

1. PRC Nomination Form (**Annex "A"**) accompanied by a *curriculum vitae* of each nominee and other evidence to prove that the candidate possesses the required qualifications. This must bear the original signatures of the members of the APO Nominating Committee or the Board as the case may be. The 2 inches x 2 inches format photo in business attire with white background (dpi 300 resolution) taken within six months prior to submission and two (2) pictures showing actual practice of the profession in hard and soft copies;

Overall ratings of each nominee should not be lower than 80%


2. NBI clearance of the nominees;
3. Ombudsman clearance for government officials or employees issued within six (6) months prior to nomination;
4. Photocopy of the nominee's PRC Identification Card;
5. Proposed citation with a maximum of 200 words prepared by the nominee (**Annex "C"**);
6. The nomination form and curriculum vitae (8.5 inches x 13 inches size) shall not exceed fifty (50) pages, ring-bound and color-coded according to the cluster of professions:

a) Health and Allied Professions – white
