Please see below the Dr. Fe Del Mundo Bulilit and Teen Health Worker Training

Program.

How to Join the Bulilit and Teens

The pupils should not necessarily come from a single class.

The breakdown is as follows:

Bulilit - GRADE 4-6 Teens – GRADE 7-12

Requirements

A. Platform

- 1. Parental consent for the pupil to attend virtual activities at home submitted to the component society Presidents.
- 2. Access to Zoom platform on either tablet or laptop
- 3. Stable internet connectivity of 5mbps.

B. Non-platform

- 1. Parental consent for the pupil to attend home activities.
- 2. Printed handouts for the pupils from the component society

Strategy

- 1. There will be 8 sessions.
- 2. Each session shall cover 2 topics per week.
- 3. Attendance. The pupil must complete atleast 80% of the total number of sessions

Teaching Resources

- 1. Appropriate topics will be delivered by the guest lecturer.
- 2. Pre-test and Post test must be completed for evaluation.
- 3. Virtual platform every Saturday 1 ½ hours at 4:00 PM
- 4. Non- platform Lecture handouts will be shared by the component society.
