Recent and past achievements should manifest his compassion and dedication as well as patriotism for staying in the country to serve the community especially indigents and for making significant contributions to national development in general and public welfare in particular. Minimum submission is 2,500 words or 5 pages. Please include two digital photos (recent colored ID photo and on full shot in medical uniform) plus a signed letter from NOMINEE addressed to TOFP 2022 stating the following: "I hereby grant permission to TOFP to use the facts herein contained and those subsequently submitted. I undertake, barring any unforeseen events, to be present during any interview required by TOFP and if selected as one of the awardees for 2022 that I will attend the presentation during the awarding ceremonies. I likewise grant the TOFP Committee to perform an independent verification of any of the facts herein contained including those in the nominations book for its accuracy."
